TUITION AND FEES

Full-time Students: Tuition for the 2023-2024 academic year is \$40,760 The minimum amount due by June 30, 2023, is 20,380.

Part-time Students: Tuition for the 2023-2024 academic year is \$27,390. The minimum amount due by June 30, 2023, is \$13,695.

Your \$350 seat deposit is automatically applied to your registration and general service fees.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

If you are receiving financial aid:

- You must accept aid in the form of Stafford loans, TEG grants, or institutional scholarships totaling *at least* 50% of tuition by **June 30**, **2023**, at 4:00 p.m. <u>If you received a scholarship, you may apply half of the total scholarship amount toward your payment</u>. For example, if you were awarded a \$10,000 academic year scholarship, you may apply \$5,000 to this first payment deadline. The remainder of your scholarship will be applied to your first payment deadline for the spring semester.
- You can access your financial aid award to determine if you meet the 50% tuition and fees criteria above by accessing STANLEY and clicking on the Campus Life tab, navigating to the Student Self Service Banner section, clicking on the Academic Services link, Financial Aid and then Award. If you do not have Stafford loans, TEG grants or institutional scholarships totaling the amount above for your enrollment status you are required to pay any shortfall to Accounting Services by the above date.

The amount of qualified aid you have accepted is located on the Account Detail for Term page on the Student Account menu. You are required to pay any shortfall by the above deadline

If you are NOT receiving financial aid:

- You will be required to pay 50% of tuition by **June 30**, **2023**, by 4:00 p.m. If you received a scholarship, you may apply half of the total scholarship amount toward your payment. See example above.
- Electronic Check (preferred method): You may elect to pay via e-check by clicking on the Campus Life tab, navigating to the Student Self Service Banner section, and clicking Pay by Check.

- In Person: Pay by check, money order, or cash in the Accounting Services Office located on the 8th floor,
